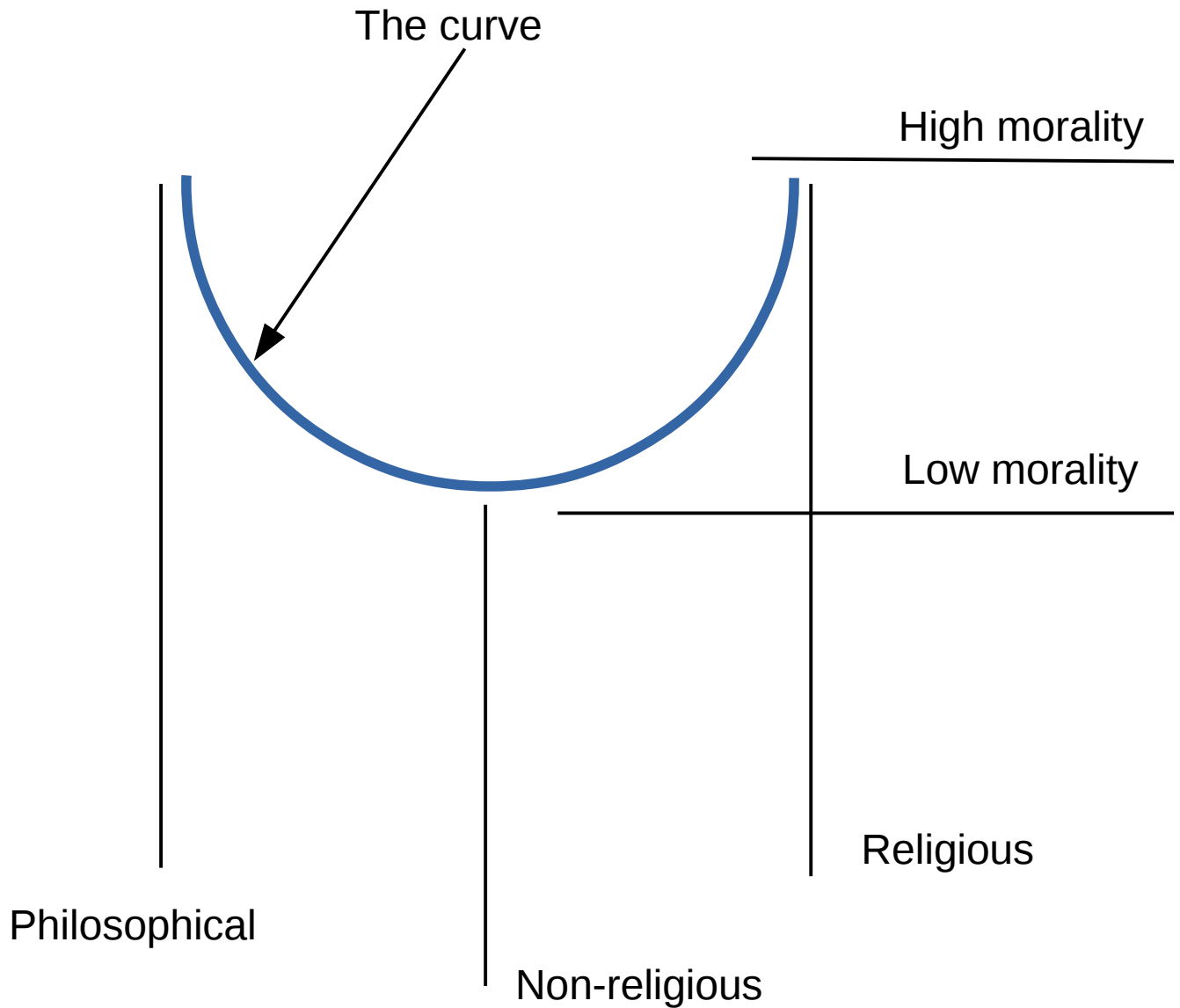


Religion, Philosophy, and Morals
